

Sydney Airport

Sydney International Airport is located just 9 kms south of the city centre. It is the main gateway to Australia. The airport has 3 terminals - International, Domestic and Qantas. An underground Airport Rail Link provides transport between the terminals.

There are nine restaurants and cafes at the airport offering a range of international and Australian cuisine, and over 130 retail outlets including a wine store, an Australian produce shop, international and Australian fashion stores, and an array of specialty stores.

Postal and fax facilities are located in the centre of Departures level 2. A medical centre is available in Terminal 1 International on level 3. There is also a pharmacy and child activity centres and Kids Cinemas in the One World and Star Alliance gate lounges.

Fax facilities are provided by Australia Post and internet access is provided at the Airport Bar in Departures level 2. Several bureaux de change and ATMs are located on Departures level 2 and Arrivals level 1 of Terminal 1 International.

Amenities for those with disabilities include showers, toilets, ramps and lowered telephones. The Tourism New South Wales desk on Arrivals level 1 of Terminal 1 International provides wheelchairs. You can also find the help desk here situated beside the glass lifts in the centre of the terminal on Departures level 2.

Transportation

By taxi

A taxi rank is located outside the Arrivals Hall in International Terminal 1. Maxi-taxis and wagons, as well as normal taxis offer baby capsules and wheelchair access, with trips downtown taking 30 minutes.

By limousine service

Another option is the limousine service, which may be booked in advance and is located in front of the International Terminal 1 Arrivals Hall.

By rail

An Airport Rail Link links the International Terminal 1, the Domestic Terminals, central Sydney and the Sydney suburbs. Trains operate every 10 minutes at peak times and every 15 minutes at weekends and off-peak times.

By bus

The bus area is located outside the International Terminal 1 Arrivals Hall, next to the airport's outdoor Piazza.
